DEFINITIONS

AKAUSHI	means fullblood/purebred red Wagyu which is registered with a recognized Wagyu Association
BY-LAWS	mean the by-laws of Wagyu Breeders of America LLC.
BREEDER	is the owner of the dam at the time of calving except in the case of notified ownership transactions including contract mating, embryo transplants and leasing.
BREEDING YEAR	means the calendar year from 1 January to 31 December.
BULL	means a Fullblood/Percentage P1-P4 Wagyu bull which is registered with a recognized Wagyu Association.
BULL OWNER	means the owner, including multiple owners, of a registered Wagyu bull, or the authorized representative, or nominee, of that owner or those owners.
CALF-DROP NUMBER	means the unique identification, consisting of a maximum of 5 alphabetic letters and/or numbers, allotted by the herd owner to each calf born in his herd for that year. (This excludes the Herd Code, the Grade Code and Year letter)
FULLBLOOD ANIMAL	means the offspring of a Wagyu sire and a Wagyu dam whose forebears originate from Japan and whose pedigrees show no evidence of any grading up from base animals or outcrossing.
DEHORND	means the animal carries two copies of the horn gene and had horns which were removed.
DESCURRED	means the animal carries one or two copies of the poll gene and had scurs which were removed.
GRADE	in relation to an animal, denotes the proportion of Wagyu blood in that animal, expressed as a percentage.
GRADE CODE	means the number or letter denoting the grade of an animal or the section of the register in which the animal is registered.
HERD CODE	is a unique identification approved by WBA for each herd for the purposes of registration. It comprises a three character code. The code may be made up of three letters, or three numbers or a combination of letters and numbers. The herd code is part of the identification with which an animal must be identified prior to registration.
HORNED	means the animal carries two copies of the horn gene and has horns.
HORNS	means the presence of horns that are attached to the skull.
IDENTIFICATION	in relation to an animal means the unique series of the following information on that animal; its Herd Code, Grade Code, Year Letter and Calf-Drop Number.
MATED BY	includes natural joining and insemination by artificial breeding.
MEMBER	means an individual, partnership or body corporate who is a financial full member of the Wagyu Breeders of America and who is entitled to enter animals in WBA's Registers.
MISHIMA	means a fullblood Mishima bloodline animal which is registered with a recognized Wagyu Association.

NAME means a word or words recorded in the register to identify an animal that is in addition to the stud prefix. Up to 26 letter spaces may be used.

PARENT VERIFICATION means use of laboratory testing by DNA to verify the parents of an animal

POLLED means the animal carries one or two copies of the poll gene.

REGISTERED in relation to an animal, means that animal is recorded in a register in accordance with these rules.

REGISTERED OWNER in relation to an animal, denotes the person recorded in the register as the owner of the animal.

SCURRED means the animal carries one or two copies of the poll gene and has scurs. SCURS means horn-like tissue that are attached to the skin rather than the skull. Can vary in size from small growths to small horn-like structures.

SEEDSTOCK means animals registered with WBA for breeding purposes

SERVED includes natural joining and insemination by artificial breeding

SERVICE includes natural joining and insemination by artificial breeding.

STUD PREFIX means a word or words recorded by WBA to identify any herd. Up to 20 letter spaces may be used.

TRANSFER DATE shall be the date on which ownership passes to the transferee.

WAGYU means a Fullblood animal whose forebears originate from Wagyu bovine animals in Japan and whose pedigree shows no evidence of any grading up from base animals or outcrossing to other breeds.

WAGYU REGISTER means the register of WBA in which records of individual Wagyu animals are kept, whether published or not, contained in computer tapes, microfilm or such other information storage systems as approved by WBA from time to time.

WBA means the Wagyu Breeders of America.

YEAR LETTER means the letter designated by WBA to denote the year of birth of a registered animal. See Table 1.

PART A - WAGYU REGULATIONS

1. MEMBERSHIP AND HERD ENROLMENT

- 1.1 Every full member who is fully financial may apply for herd enrolment. The member may with such application provide the information required in relation to the herd and tender the fees payable upon herd enrolment.
- 1.2 Each full member may apply for the approval of a herd code which consists of not more than 3 characters. This herd code forms part of the permanent identification system.
- 1.3 Members warrant to use their best endeavours to comply with requirements of the Bylaws namely Part A - Wagyu Regulations, Part B - Members Code of Conduct and Part C - WBA Truth and labeling code of conduct, as may be determined by WBA and its agents and representatives for any loss, damage or other liabilities arising from members' mistakes, negligence or deliberately misleading conduct arising from the member's obligations under the Bylaws.

2. WAGYU REGISTERS

The Wagyu Register shall contain the following sections:

HERDBOOK
FULLBLOODS
PERCENTAGE GRADE (P4) - 93%+
PERCENTAGE GRADES (P1-P3)
SLAUGHTER

Herdbook Register (HBR) : The breeding register for all Wagyu Fullblood 100% and Percentage Wagyu F4 93+ males and females which are DNA parent verified to their sire and dam.

Black, Red and Composite (the result of combined breeding of black and red Wagyu), Yellow, White, Grey animals are registered in the Herdbook Register with the color field differentiating these groups of animals.

Composite registered animals have a "CC" in brackets [CC] on their registration certificate immediately after the animal's registered name. Progeny of Composite registered animals are only eligible for registration in the Composite Register.

Content Register: The breeding register for Wagyu influenced animals not eligible for registration in the Herdbook.

Grading Up: This system allows for the recording of Percentage Grade 1 Wagyu (P1) 50+%, Percentage Grade 2 Wagyu (P2) 75+%, and Percentage Grade 3 Wagyu (P3) 87+% animals where the objective is to produce a Percentage Grade 4 Wagyu (P4) 93+%. DNA sire verification is required for P1 animals. DNA parent verification is required for both the sire and dam for P2, P3, and P4 animals.

Slaughter Register: The non-breeding register for slaughter animals only which are, Percentage Grade 1 Wagyu 50%, Percentage Grade 2 Wagyu 75%, and Percentage Grade 3 Wagyu 87%+, Percentage Grade 4 Wagyu 93%+ and Wagyu Fullblood 100% males and females. **DNA parent**

verification is required. A DNA sample must be submitted to WBA to enable quality assurance of parentage. No progeny from any Slaughter Registered animals are eligible to be registered with the WBA.

2.1 HERDBOOK REGISTERS(HBR)

- 2.1.1 As red and black Wagyu are regarded as two distinct breeds, they (and progeny from red with black matings) shall be recorded in separate sections of the register as separate lines of cattle.
- 2.1.2 Progeny from black animals mated to red animals or vice versa are to be recorded as Composite animals.
- 2.1.3 Composite animals have a "CC" in brackets [CC] on their registration certificate immediately after the animal's registered name.

2.2 FULLBLOOD GRADE

- 2.2.1 An animal will be regarded as a fullblood whose forebears originate from Japan and whose pedigrees show no evidence of any grading up from base animals or outcrossing to other breeds.
- 2.2.2 An animal will be regarded as a fullblood in a register of recognized overseas Wagyu breed organizations, provided that the regulations governing the entry of such animals as fullbloods comply with these bylaws governing registration and are approved by WBA.
- 2.2.3 If the animal is registered with the Wagyu Breeders of America or any other Wagyu registry organization, evidence of parentage verification must be provided or a percentage test must be completed with WBA.
- 2.2.4 DNA parent verification is required to sire and dam.
- 2.2.5 Animals registered in this section shall be given a grade code of "F".

2.3 PERCENTAGE GRADE 4 - (93+%)

- 2.3.1 An animal will be regarded as Percentage Grade 4 (93+%) if in a register of recognized overseas Wagyu breed organizations, provided that the regulations governing the entry of such animals as percentage grade comply with these by-laws governing registration and are approved by WBA.
- 2.3.2 If the animal is registered with any other Wagyu registry organization, evidence of parentage verification must be provided or a percentage test must be completed with the WBA.
- 2.3.3 Animals produced as a result of a 4th cross in the Grading-Up Section, that are 15/16th (minimum 93% Wagyu breed content) Wagyu and DNA parent verified to sire and dam are eligible for classification as Percentage Grade 4.
- 2.3.4 Animals identified by the crossbred Wagyu Test with minimum 93% Wagyu breed content and parent verified to a fullblood or percentage 4 (93+%) sire and parent verified to an P4 (minimum 93+% Wagyu breed content) or % Wagyu breed content) dam are eligible for classification as Percentage Grade 4.
- 2.3.6 **Animals registered in this section shall be given a grade code of (P4)..**

2.4 GRADING-UP SECTION

- 2.4.1 Males and Females may be admitted to the grading up section if they are the progeny of a Fullblood or Percentage Grade 4 sire and out of a base female of

any breed (or cross of any breed) or if they meet the minimum level of percentage Wagyu content as determined by the Crossbred Wagyu Test and specified in Table 2 for the relevant grade.

- 2.4.2 Animals registered in this section shall be given a grade code applicable to the Minimum % Wagyu Content classification or relevant generation as specified in Table 2.
- 2.4.3 The progeny of a Grade 0 (Base) animal requires a DNA parent verification to its sire to qualify for registration as Percentage Grade 1 (P1). The progeny of a Percentage Grade 1, 2 or 3 (P1, P2, or P3) animal requires a DNA parent verification to its sire and dam to qualify for registration.
- 2.4.4 Animals recorded under this section will be recorded with a (P) and Grade Code. Example an Percentage Grade 2 would be recorded a (P2).**

Table 2 - Grade Code assignment based on Generation or Minimum % Wagyu Content

Grade Code	Generation	Minimum % Wagyu Content
0	0 = Base Animal	Less than 50%
1	1 = Crossbred Wagyu P1	50+%
2	2 = Crossbred Wagyu P2	75+%
3	3 = Crossbred Wagyu P3	87+%
4	4 = Crossbred Wagyu P4	93+%

2.5 **SLAUGHTER REGISTER (SR)**

The Slaughter Register is to allow breeders and marketers access to a professionally prepared pedigree certificate for animals destined for slaughter and to facilitate the capture of performance data on these animals.

To meet with slaughter registration eligibility:

- 2.5.1 Entry into the SR is available to commercial cattle under 12 months of age sired by registered Wagyu bulls and destined for slaughter. They must have minimum Wagyu breed content of Crossbred Wagyu P1 (50%).
- 2.5.2 An electronic Slaughter Register certificate will be generated for the slaughter animal.
- 2.5.3 WBA Registered sires of SR cattle can be either natural mating, Artificial insemination (AI) or Embryo transfer (ET).
- 2.5.4 Up to 3 WBA registered Multiple sires per calf are permitted.
- 2.5.5 If animals being the progeny of embryos are candidates for SR, then proof of ownership is required.
- 2.5.6 Female animals registered in the SR are to be kept for slaughter purposes only. No progeny of Slaughter registered females are eligible for registration. All SR certificates are to state "This animal is for slaughter only and is not be used for breeding purposes".

2.6 **BASE ANIMALS**

- 2.6.1 Base animals shall be identified with a number by branding, tattooing or ear tagging.
- 2.7.2 The grade code of base animas is "0".

2.7.3 The breed (or the apparent crossbreeds) of the base animals shall be recorded.

3 ELIGIBILITY FOR SEEDSTOCK REGISTRATION

To meet with Seedstock registration eligibility and in registering animals with WBA:

3.1 All animals registered must be DNA typed at any WBA approved American or international laboratory where WBA has a current genetic testing services agreement to enable parent verification by DNA for future progeny.

3.2 PARENT VERIFICATION - DNA genotyping

3.2.1 WBA requires a DNA profile and parentage verification of all animals registered in the Herdbook or the Grading Up Section at a level decided by the WBA and in the format required by WBA.

3.2.2 The use of international laboratories for parentage verification is restricted to WBA approved facilities from which information can be supplied in a format that will allow it to be loaded on the WBA system.

3.2.3 WBA will undertake SNP PV based on testing results provided to it by genetic testing service providers where a minimum of 500 SNP (as determined by WBA) are provided.

3.2.4 WBA requires, and each member grants to WBA a perpetual, royalty free right of access to the sample (where available) and to DNA profiles from this sample for the purposes of maintaining the integrity of the Wagyu Herdbook, Breedplan analyses, and EBVs, test of products derived from these tests for the benefit of WBA and its members as a group.

3.2.5 WBA requires pedigree, DNA profile and performance data submitted from members to be held on the WBA database and members grant to WBA and its members as a group.

3.2.6 The genotype generated data from each registered animal will be used in WAGYU BREEDPLAN analysis and will be used by WBA for research and/or publication of dissemination of EBVs on individual animals.

3.2.7 WBA will notify members where it seeks to access the member's sample or the DNA for conducting testing.

3.2.8 Member will be provided with raw data upon request. The member submitting DNA for testing is recognized as the owner of the DNA and will be provided testing results.

3.2.9 Wagyu Breeders of America will release all DNA testing results upon request by the member to any other registry. WBA claims no ownership of the DNA other than the right to use the results as stated in 3.2.5 & 3.2.6 & 3.2.7.

3.3 IDENTIFICATION

3.3.1 Every animal born in a registered herd and eligible for registration shall be permanently identified with the following:

DNA typing

Tattoo

Ear tag

- 3.3.2 Every registered animal shall have a unique identifier that includes the Herd Code, Grade Code, Year Letter and calf-Drop Number. The Year Letter will denote the year in which the calf was born and the Calf-Drop Number shall so far as is practicable, normally indicate the order in which the calf was born in relation to other calves born in the same herd in that year.
Eg. ABCFM5 where Herd Code = ABC, Grade Code = F(fullblood), Year Letter =M (2016) , Calf- Drop Number = 5 (5th calf born in the herd in 2016).

4 PERFORMANCE RECORDING

- 4.1** Wagyu BREEDPLAN participants must be a full member of WBA.
- 4.1.5 All 50k SNP's test will be automatically submitted to breedplan.
- 4.2** Members are encouraged to join BREEDPLAN and supply the following additional data for performance recording, for example -
- 4.2.1 Birth weight
- 4.2.2 200 day weight (taken between 170 and 230 days of age)
- 4.2.3 400 day weight (taken between 370 and 430 days of age)
- 4.2.4 600 day weight (taken between 570 and 630 days of age)
- 4.2.5 Scanning data
- 4.2.6 Carcase performance data
- 4.3** Animals must be registered to enable access to BREEDPLAN services.

5 GENERAL REGULATIONS

5.1 BREEDER'S RECORDS

- 5.1.1 It shall be the duty of members, being the owners of registered animals, to keep proper records of the breeding activities of the herds. All such records so kept, shall be open for examination by a person authorized by WBA to examine the same.

5.2 HORNED, DEHORNED, POLLED OR SCURRED STATUS

- 5.2.1 The written registration application must contain information indicating if an animal is Horned, Dehorned, Polled or Scurred.
- 5.2.2 Any animal registered as Polled or Scurred must be DNA tested to determine if it is Homozygous polled or Heterozygous polled using a test to be specified by WBA.
- 5.2.3 Dehorning may be performed and is at the discretion of the breeder. Dehorning is encouraged as early as possible in the interest of animal welfare.

5.3 DEREGISTRATION

- 5.3.1 Any animal may upon the written application of its registered owner may be deregistered. However for pedigree integrity, reporting of Breedplan analysis, EBVs and maintenance of datasets underpinning genetic predictions used by WBA, animals with progeny will be maintained in WBA registers to allow complete records.

WBA may:

- 5.3.2 Decline to register or deregister any animal or to record the transfer of any animal if the person applying for such registration or recording shall fail to pay upon demand any money due to WBA prescribed in these By-laws:
- 5.3.3 Cancel or defer any registration of any animal if the person for the time being recorded as the owner of such animal shall fail to pay within 90 days after demand any monies to be payable to WBA on any account whatsoever;
- 5.3.4 Cancel or defer the entry in the register of any animal sold, exchanged, leased or otherwise disposed of if no application for transfer of such animal be lodged with WBA within the time prescribed and if the prescribed fee be not paid within four months of such dispositions;
- 5.3.5 Cancel or defer any entry in the register of any animal where right of access to the sample, DNA, or DNA profile is withheld or refused by the member.
- 5.3.6 Cancel any animal registration where WBA is reasonably satisfied that an animal does not meet the registration standards as set out in these Bylaws.
- 5.3.7 Deregistration of any animal shall not affect the registration or entry of any calf of which such animal is the sire or dam if the registration or entry of such calf was recorded during the prescribed period for registration of such animal nor shall deregistration alone constitute a disqualification from registration.

5.4 GENETIC CONDITIONS

- 5.4.1 Members are required to report to WBA any animals showing clinical systems that may have a genetic basis.
- 5.4.2 As carriers of single copy of lethal recessive conditions are clinically normal, all animals tested to the "WBA Lethal recessive conditions of Wagyu" panel must have their status identified on their individual registration.
- 5.4.3 Testing for their recessive conditions may be required if any genetic material is destined for an export market in which the importing country and/or breed association request such information.

6 TRANSFERS

- 6.1 Upon sale, exchange, gift, lease or other settlement of a registered animal, or interest therein registered with WBA, notification of such shall be lodged by the animal's registered owner with a completed, signed transfer application for the registered animal to be transferred on the back of the original pedigree registration certificate or online if available.
- 6.2 The WBA does not regulate the sale of non registered calves born or unborn. Calves sold prior to registration shall reflect the correct breeder when registered as defined in the Bylaws.
- 6.3 Transfer applications must be forwarded to WBA together with the prescribed transfer fee within 60 days of the date of transfer/sale. A late fee to be accepted must accompany transfer applications received after 60 days.
- 6.4 Transfer fees are considered to be the responsibility of the breeder unless agreed to by both parties.
- 6.5 Base dams: The above regulations also apply to registered Base dams.
- 6.6 Full mating details must be entered on the transfer certificate.
- 6.7 Transfer of registered animals from approved overseas societies must conform to WBA's requirements.

- 6.8** In the event that members purchase unregistered animals and apply to have them registered, all transfer and registration fees will be payable, and all requirements for registration shall be met.
- 6.9** With the transfer of genetic material, the vendor is obligated to supply relevant DNA information.

7 CATTLE LEASING

- 7.1** WBA recognises the existence of cattle-leasing arrangements and lessees are deemed to be owners for all purposes of these By-laws for the period of the lease.

8 MATINGS - ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION (AI) OR NATURAL SERVICE

- 8.1** A member may use AI or natural service by registered Fullblood or Percentage Grade 4 93+% bulls in a registered herd with progeny eligible for registration as per section 3.
- 8.2** MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP OF SIRES & DAMS
- 8.2.1** Only four (4) shareholding in a bull or female will be registered with WBA at any one time. When a sire or dam becomes the subject of multiple ownership, WBA must be notified in writing, before the animal is used by the new owners.
- 8.2.2** One of the four member owners shall become the nominated owner as WBA contact.

9 EMBRYO TRANSFER (ET)

- 9.1** Progeny born from transplant of embryos flushed from dams registered and domiciled in The United States of America by registered sires, will be eligible for registration, provided that the member indicates this in the question column headed "Embryo" on the registration format at the time of applying for registration. The breeder of such embryos shall be deemed to be the member who joined the animals for embryo production.

10 IMPORTATION

10.1 REGISTERED CATTLE IMPORTS

- 10.1.1** Animals registered in any other country approved by WBA will be considered for registration on WBA's Registers on receipt of the following (which must be forwarded to WBA within 2 months of import):
- 10.1.1.1** A certified copy of a four-generation registration certificate from the approved international society.
 - 10.1.1.2** A certified copy of a transfer certificate.
 - 10.1.1.3** A certified copy of an export certificate
 - 10.1.1.4** In the case of all progeny bred by embryo transfer, a certified copy of the parent verification certificate.
 - 10.1.1.5** Where an animal or pending progeny is by a sire or dam which is not on WBA's register, the sire or dam's registration certificate, DNA profile and the prescribed fee must also be provided.
 - 10.1.1.6** Payment of the prescribed fees.
- 10.1.2** Animals registered as Fullbloods or Percentage Grade 4 (93+%) in registers of recognized international Wagyu breed organizations shall be eligible for

registration in WBA's Registers, provided that the regulations governing the entry of such animals comply with these By-laws governing registration and evidence of DNA parent verification to sire and dam is provided.

10.2 IMPORTATION OF RECIPIENT DAMS

- 10.2.1 In the case of recipient cows being imported, a prescribed fee per donor cow shall be paid. The following documents must be forwarded to WBA:
 - 10.2.1.1 Donor cow's registration certificate.
 - 10.2.1.2 Donor cow's DNA or blood typing certificate.
 - 10.2.1.3 Export certificate covering the import of the recipient cows.
 - 10.2.1.4 Export certificate covering the import of the recipient cows.

10.3 IMPORTATION OF EMBRYOS

- 10.3.1 All imported embryos must be recorded on the embryo register by the importer/member within 2 months of importation.
- 10.3.2 For any imported embryos a copy of the DNA profile/blood type and registration certificate of the sire and donor dam must accompany the registration form..
- 10.3.3 If a member sells an imported embryo or pregnant recipient he must transfer an embryo registration certificate to the new owner. WBA Form " Application for Ownership Transfer of Embryo" on the back of the Embryo Certificate shall be completed and forwarded to WBA and the appropriate fees paid.

11 CLONING

- 10.1. 1 WBA will allow the registration of Cloned animals.
- 10.1. 2 All cloned animals will be marked with the words (CLONE) in the animals names
- 10.1. 3 All progeny derived from a sire or dam will be labeled as (CLONE). And Considered a Clone.
- 10.1. 4 No data from a (CLONE) will be used in any EBV program.
- 10.1. 5 All animals will have a registration number that starts with CL. An example of a Clone registered animal would be Reg Number- CLE109

Members Code of Conduct

1. Members should note that WBA expects members to observe the highest standards in all dealings, in particular considers any form of misrepresentation to be detrimental to the interest of WBA.
2. All members must adhere to the rules of WBC. Members who intentionally manipulate or disregard the rules thereby harming WBA interest will be fined. Continued disregard of bylaws may lead to member expulsion at the discretion of WBA. An outside mediator, agreed upon by both parties, will be required for any member expulsion hearing. The cost of the mediator will be at the expense of the non prevailing party. The burden of proof will lie with the WBA.

3. All transactions not directly involving the WBA are considered private transactions. The WBA will not serve as a mediator in any capacity for matter concerning private transactions. The WBA strongly encourages all its members to seek legal advice before commencing a transaction.
4. Any member expelled shall forfeit all subscription previously paid by member and all rights in any claim upon WBA. Any member expelled will have all information on their registered animals downloaded and forwarded to the expelled member for transfer out of the registry. The registry will retain a copy of the information as allowed in Section 3.

Truth and Labeling Code of Conduct

OBJECTIVE

The WBA is founded on the principals of truth and labeling. It is the objective of the WBA to ensure that all transactions, advertisements, and labels used or created by Wagyu Breeders of America members adhere to the highest standards of honesty and transparency. It is necessary that all grades of wagyu livestock be clearly identifiable to provide potential purchasers with the ability to make the most informed buying decision. Record keeping and transactions shall be done with a sense of obligation to the livestock industry and consumers. Members who willfully manipulate information regarding their animals in disregard to the truth and labeling code of conduct have the potential to be fined or expelled.

1. Live Animals
 - 1.1 Seller will disclose wagyu percentage of all animals.
 - 1.2 Sellers will disclose if an animal test positive for any recessive genes.
 - 1.3 Seller will disclose results of any SCD or Tenderness test.
 - 1.4 Seller will disclose whether a female has undergone embryo transplant.
 - 1.5 Seller will disclose semen interest of bulls where less than 100% is offered for sale.
2. Slaughtered Animals.
 - 2.1 All meat products carrying the WBA label are required to affix the QR code label to the packaging that includes wagyu content percentage.
 - 2.2 It is the position that incorrect usage of the WBA label is fraud punishable under the rules of the code of conduct.
 - 2.3 The purposeful manipulation or layout of a label that leads to the misrepresentation of the product will be considered fraud.
 - 2.4 No label or advertising will use the word "Kobe" or any phrase incorporating the phrase such as "American Style Kobe Beef".
3. Genetics
 - 3.1 Embryos
 - 3.1.1 Seller will disclose grade of embryos
 - 3.1.2 Seller will disclose if Sire or Dam carries any recessive genes.
 - 3.2 Semen
 - 3.2.1 Seller will disclose If the Sire carries any recessive genes.
